Who:
Community Educators who want to integrate hands on gardening experiences within their organization.

What:
The Urban Agriculture Community Outreach Project provides Community leaders with a garden tower and all the supplies necessary to grow food/plants in your organization for up to one year. The Garden Tower is a unique vertical soil-based system that allows you to grow up to 70 plants in just 4 square feet of space. Its design is made of 100% recyclable food-grade plastic and rotates at 360° for easy, accessible, weed free gardening. The Garden Tower has a built-in vermicomposting system and is on wheels for easy transportation. For more information about the Garden Tower visit: www.gardentowerproject.com.

When:
Applications are accepted year-round, please allow up to two weeks for a response.

Where:
Your organization! The Garden Tower itself takes up 4 sq. ft of space, an additional 1.5ft around the tower is required for grow lights. You will also need space for starting seedlings. The seedling light is 2ft long and the base of the stand is approx. 1ft wide.

Why:
The benefits to gardening are vast; it can improve your health, help the environment, save you money and improve quality of life. Gardening is a unique way for individuals to build a relationship with their food and develop life skills such as problem-solving, coping, nurturing and resilience. Vegetable gardening can be a satisfying and rewarding activity with just a little direction, some good advice and inspiration.
